

The GBI 2017 Crime Statistics Summary Report is out. Based on the reported Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) Index Crimes (page 4), Henry County's crime index rate (per 1,000 people) dropped from 26.9 to 25.4. Per capita, Henry County now has the lowest crime rate, when compared to the surrounding/bordering counties. The crimes included on the report include violent crimes as well as Burglary, Larceny, Stolen Vehicles, and Arson.

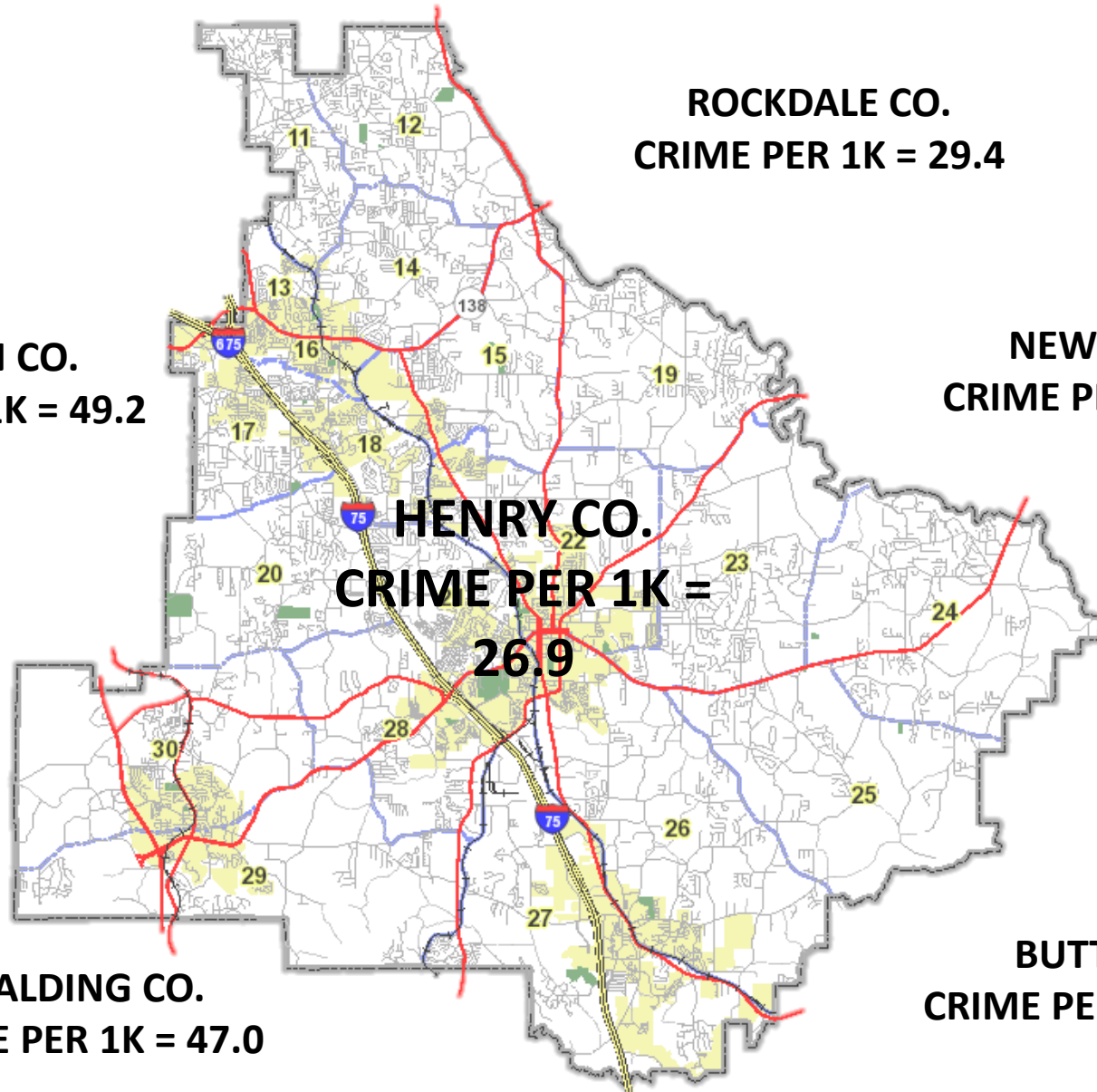

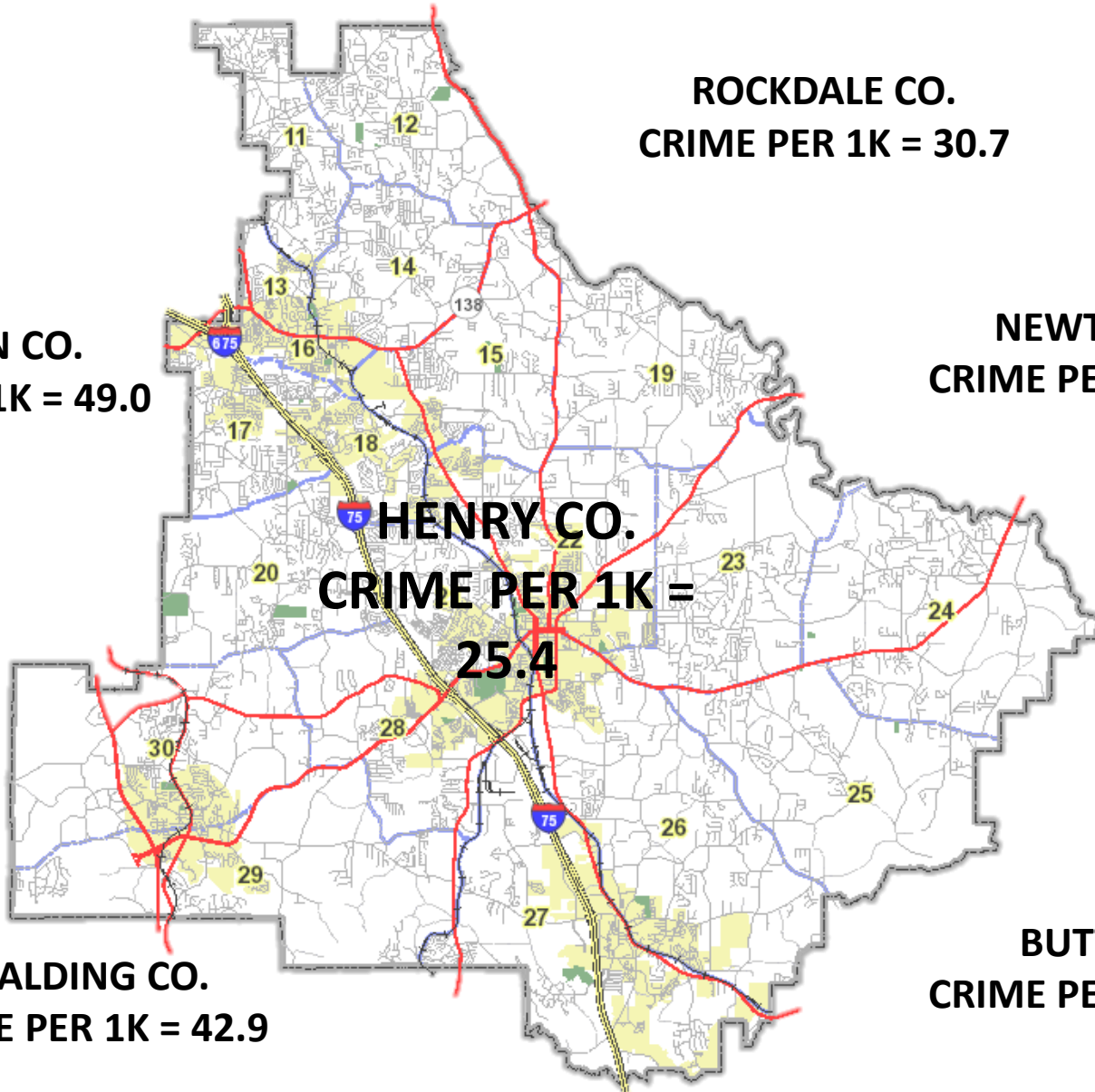
