Questions and Answers

- 1. Question:** Given that Lumin8 engineered the plans for this project, does that preclude them from bidding on said project? If not, wouldn't that represent a conflict of interest?

- 2. Question:** What percentage of the contract will be required for the bid bond on the subject project?
Answer: **Please refer to Section II specifications part C-Bond Requirements. "All Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid for the complete work."**
- 3. Question:** Note 19 on sheet 27-0001 states that pavement markings that are to be removed/replaced are to be covered under the signal lump sum. Can the department specify as to which pavement markings are to be covered here?
Answer: **It is the general pavement markings near the intersection of Bill Gardner Pkwy and Lester Mill Road.**
